

Frequently Asked Questions about VBS 2021

- **What date is VBS Rocky Railway?**
 - June 21st - 25th

- **What time does VBS begin and end?**
 - VBS will run each day from 9:00am to 11:00am.

- **What should my child bring to VBS?**
 - Comfortable clothes and shoes they can run and get dirty in, a refillable water bottle labeled with their name, and a fun attitude!

- **What should my child wear on a water day?**
 - If there is a water day, please have your child dress in a bathing suit, with their clothes on top. They should also bring a towel and a change of clothes in a bag labeled with their name. If there is a water day during the week, we will make sure you know!

- **What happens if it rains?**
 - We are praying for beautiful weather, but if we have a rainy day we will bring all stations inside. While inside, due to the current Fishers' Mask Mandate, all children age five and older will be required to wear a face covering.

- **If I am a volunteer, when should I arrive?**
 - As a volunteer, please arrive at 8:30am. This will help us organize the day and be ready to greet the children at 9:00am.

- **Are snacks or water being provided?**
 - There will be no snack station this year. Please have your child bring their own refillable water bottle, labeled with their name.

- **Is there a maximum number of participants?**
 - Each grade level has a maximum number of 26 participants. Once your child's grade is full, we will put you on a waiting list. If we have enough volunteers, we will consider adding an additional group so that everyone can participate.

- **How old does my child need to be to participate?**
 - VBS is open for Preschoolers (4 years old as of September 1st 2021) to 4th Grade. We ask that all preschoolers are potty trained.

- **Do volunteers require a registration fee?**
 - If you are interested in volunteering, please email Kaitlyn Armiger, karmiger@sldmfishers.org. We are in need of adults and teens to help each group. If you are a volunteer, your child's participation fee will be waved.

- **If I am an adult volunteer with a child too young for VBS, what do I do?**
 - We offer a free nursery for children of adult volunteers, newborn to 3 years old. Unfortunately, you will not be able to have a younger child stay with you while you help or lead a group. - **How old does my child need to be to volunteer?**
 - All 5th graders and up are welcome to volunteer. We are happy to sign off on any volunteer hours you may need for school!

- **Will the children and adult volunteers be wearing masks?**
 - We are following the Fishers Health Department directives. All outdoor activities will be spaced by group, and masks will not be required. If a station is inside the school building, children and volunteers will be required to wear a mask. The only indoor station as of now will be our Music Station. If it is

a rainy day all activities will be indoors, requiring masks.
